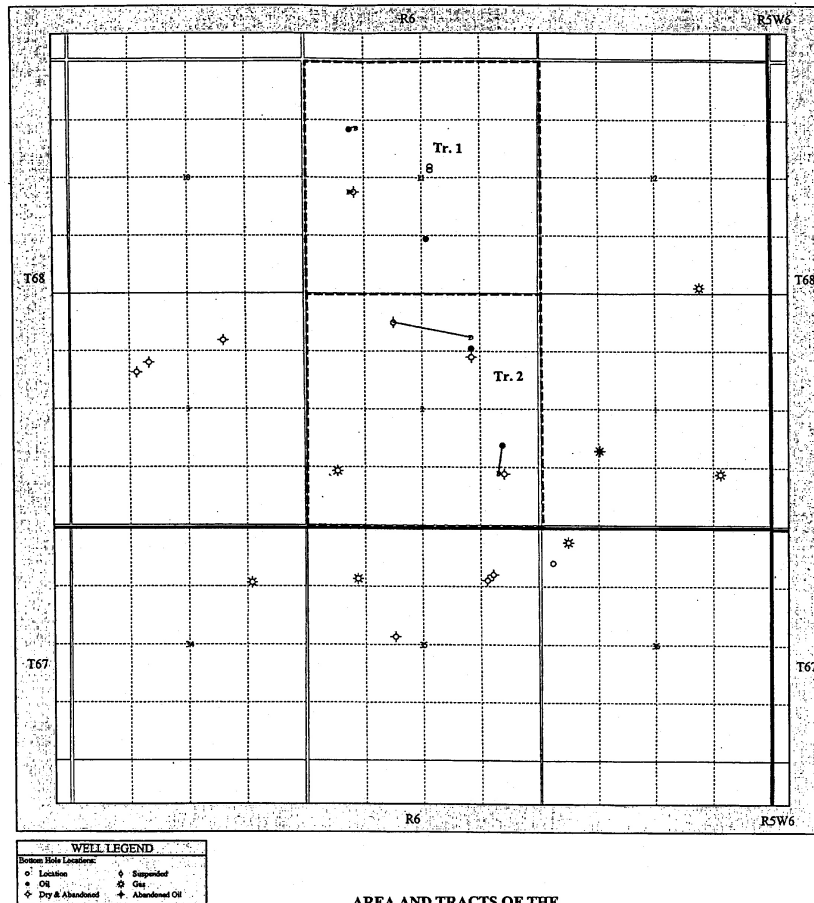

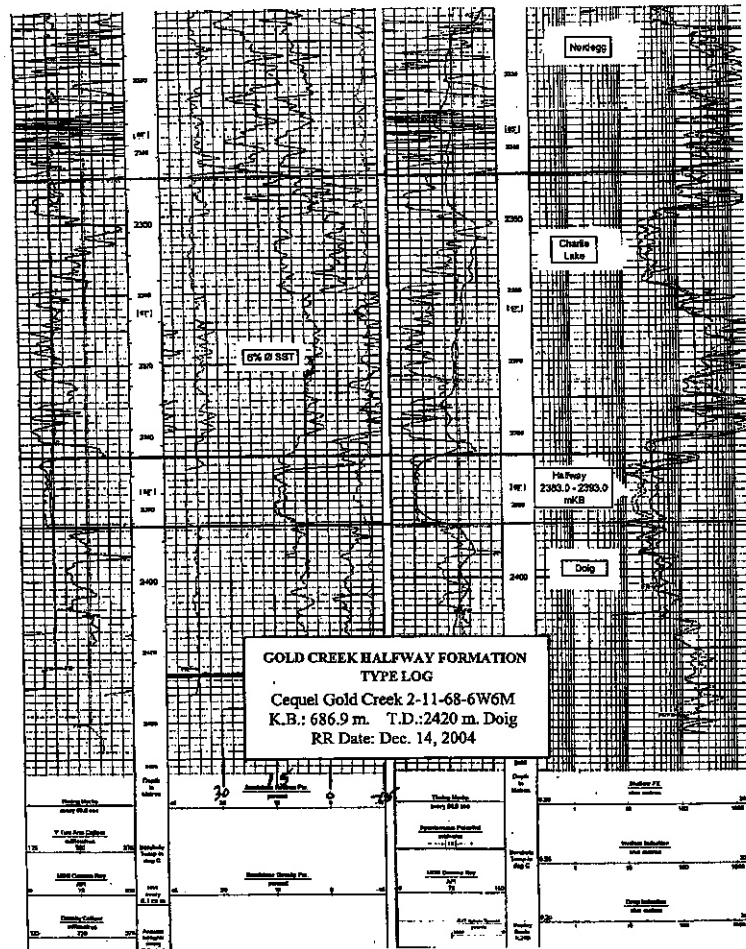
AREA AND TRACTS OF THE
