OH RANCH HERITAGE RANGELAND DESIGNATION ORDER

The following lands are designated as a heritage rangeland to be known as OH Ranch Heritage Rangeland.

FIRSTLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the seventeenth (17) township, in the second (2) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

The west half of section thirty (30).

SECONDLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the seventeenth (17) township, in the third (3) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

Sections twenty-four (24) and twenty-five (25), the north east quarter of section twenty-six (26), the east half of section twenty-seven (27), the south east quarter of section thirty-four (34), the south half of section thirty-five (35) and the south west quarter of section thirty-six (36), all those portions of the north west quarter of section thirteen (13), the north east quarter of section twenty-two (22) and the north west quarter of section twenty-three (23) which lie generally to the north of the fence line, all those portions of the south east quarter of section twenty-three (23), the west half of section twenty-seven (27) and the south west quarter of section thirty-four (34) which lie generally to the east of the fence line and all those portions of the north east quarter of section fourteen (14), the north west quarter of section twenty-two (22) and the north east quarter of section twenty-three (23) which lie generally to the north and east of the fence line as shown upon a map or plan of record on file in the Department of Tourism, Parks and Recreation at Edmonton as P0462 GEN.

THIRDLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the eighteenth (18) township, in the third (3) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

Section twenty-nine (29), the north half of section thirty (30) and the west half of section thirty-one (31), all those portions of the south west quarter of section twenty-eight (28) which lie generally to the west of the left bank of the Highwood River and all those portions of the north half of section twenty-eight (28) which lie generally to the north and west of the left bank of the Highwood River and to the south and east of the southeasterly limit of a surveyed roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office at Calgary for the Southern Alberta Land Registration District as No. 4890HY.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING:

Four and twenty-four hundredths (4.24) hectares (10.48 acres), more or less, required for a surveyed roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office as No. 871 0283.

FOURTHLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the eighteenth (18) township, in the fourth (4) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

Sections twenty-five (25) and thirty-six (36) and the north east quarter of section thirty-five (35) and all those portions of the north east quarter of section twenty-six (26), the north east quarter of section thirty-four (34) and the south half and north west quarter of section thirty-five (35) which lie generally to the east of the fence line as shown upon a map or plan of record on file in the Department of Tourism, Parks and Recreation at Edmonton as P0462 GEN.

FIFTHLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the nineteenth (19) township, in the third (3) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

Sections sixteen (16) and eighteen (18), the south west quarter of section six (6) and the north half and south west quarter of section seven (7).

SIXTHLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the nineteenth (19) township, in the fourth (4) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

Sections one (1), twelve (12) and thirteen (13).

The lands herein described contain four thousand two hundred seventy-seven and three hundred sixty-eight thousandths (4277.368) hectares (10569.61 acres), more or less.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council orders that

- (a) effective May 1, 2008, the land described in Appendix A and shown on the sketch in Appendix B is separated from the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 and annexed to the Town of Okotoks,
- (b) any taxes owing to the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 at the end of April 30, 2008 in respect of the annexed land are transferred to and become payable to the Town of Okotoks together with any lawful penalties and costs levied in respect of those taxes, and the Town of Okotoks upon collecting those taxes, penalties and costs must pay them to the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31,
- (c) for the purposes of taxation in 2008, the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 must assess and tax the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it,
- (d) taxes payable in 2008 in respect of the assessable land and any improvements to it are to be paid to the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 and the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 shall remit those taxes to the Town of Okotoks, and
- (e) the assessor for the Town of Okotoks must assess for the purpose of taxation in 2009 and subsequent years, the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it,

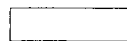
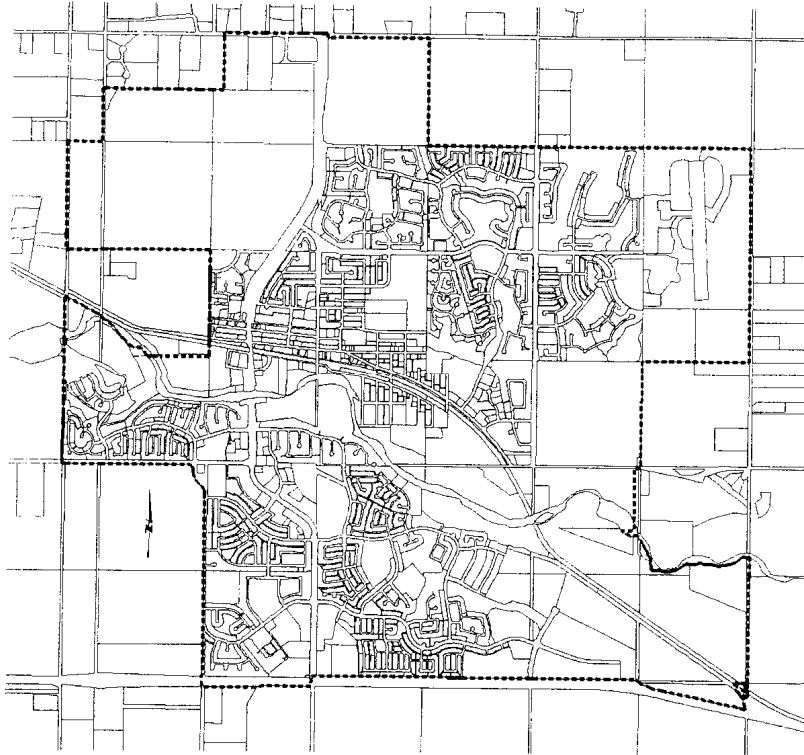

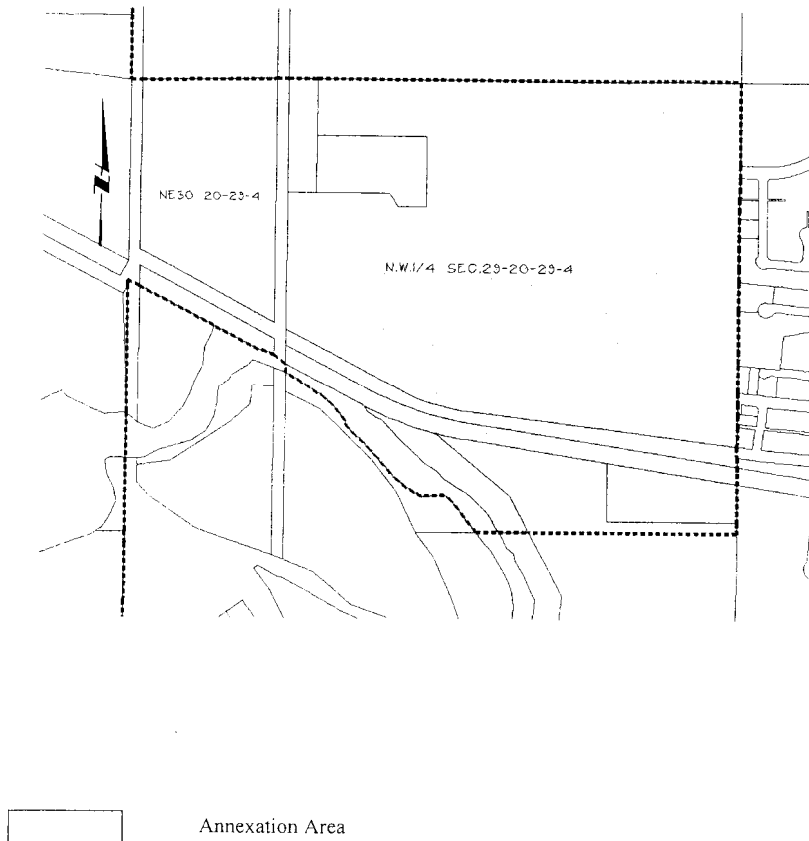

ANNEXED TO THE TOWN OF OKOTOKS



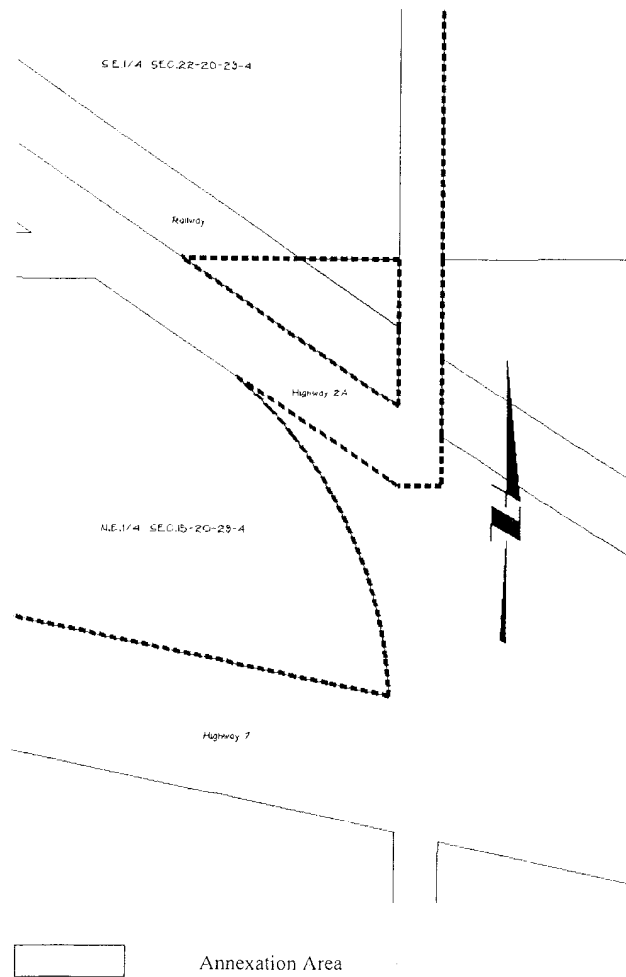
Annexation Area

APPENDIX C

ORDER

- 1 In this Order, "annexed land" means the land described in Appendix A and shown on the sketches in Appendix B.
- 2 For taxation purposes in 2008 and subsequent years up to and including 2012, Block 1, Plan 8911784 and the assessable improvements to it
 - (a) must be assessed by the Town of Okotoks on the same basis as if they had remained in Municipal District of Foothills No. 31, and
 - (b) must be taxed by the Town of Okotoks in respect of each assessment class that applies to the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it using the tax rate established by Municipal District of Foothills No. 31.
- 3 Where in any taxation year, up to and including 2012, a portion of the annexed land referred to under section 2
 - (a) becomes a new parcel of land created as a result of subdivision or separation of title by registered plan of subdivision or by instrument or any other method that occurs at the request of, or on behalf of, the landowner, or
 - (b) is redesignated at the request of, or on behalf of the landowner under the Town of Okotoks Land Use Bylaw to another designation,section 2 ceases to apply at the end of that taxation year in respect of that portion of the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it.
- 4 After section 2 ceases to apply to a portion of the annexed land in a taxation year, that portion of the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it must be assessed and taxed for the purposes of property taxes in the following year in the same manner as other property of the same assessment class in the Town of Okotoks is assessed and taxed.
- 5 The Town of Okotoks shall pay to the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 forty thousand dollars (\$40 000.00) not later than 30 days after the date this Order in Council is made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

(Blackfoot First Nations Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Regulation)

Pursuant to the *First Nations Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Act (FNSCORA)* and the *Blackfoot Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Regulation* made under that Act, the Province of Alberta as represented by the Minister of Culture and Community Spirit hereby gives notice of receipt of a repatriation application from a member of the Blood Tribe for an object in the Government of Alberta's collections at the Royal Alberta Museum.

The application is for the repatriation of two rattles (H67.251.20, .21) and two cloth wrappings containing pieces of fungus and tobacco (H67.251.134, .136), all originating with the Blood Reserve, and an Otter Tipi flag (H67.276.134), which

originated with the Montana Blackfeet. The rattles and cloth wrappings containing the fungus and tobacco belonged to a Beaver Bundle that was previously repatriated. All material was purchased by the Royal Alberta Museum in 1967.

Any person with interest in these objects, who either wishes to make written representations to the Minister relating to this application or to submit an application of their own, must do so within 30 days after publication of this notice in The Alberta Gazette. For further information, an interested person should contact the Assistant Curator of Ethnology at the Royal Alberta Museum, 12845-102 Avenue, Edmonton, Alberta T5N 0M6. Repatriation of the above pieces to the Mookaakin Heritage Foundation, as the designated representative of the Blood Tribe, may proceed after the 30 day period if the object listed in the application is determined to meet the criteria of a sacred ceremonial object as defined in FNSCORA, no additional applications or contrary written representations have been made, and if the Minister considers repatriation to be appropriate.
