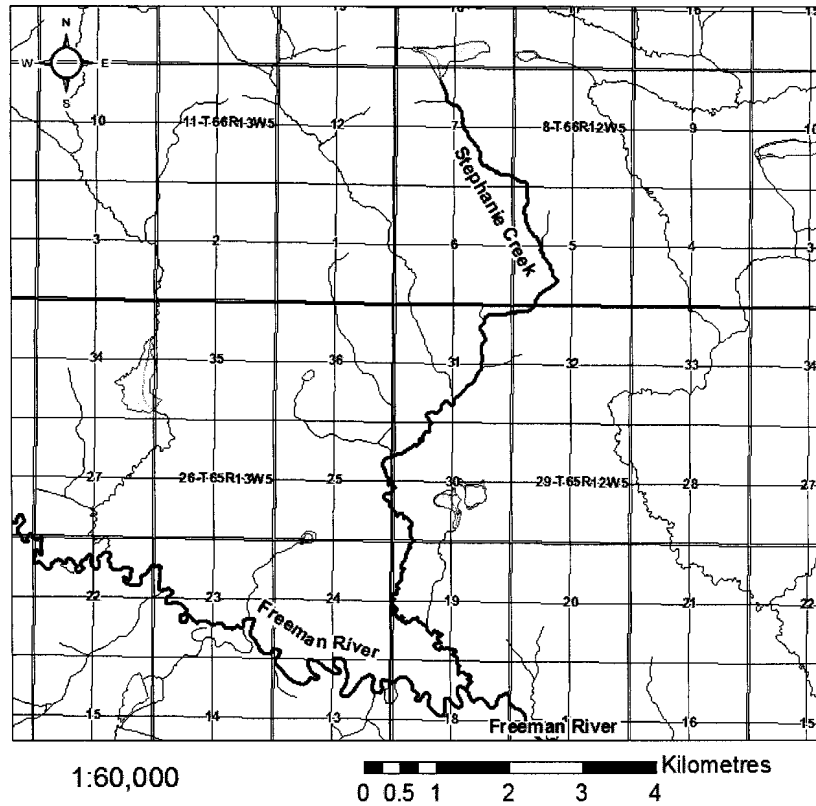

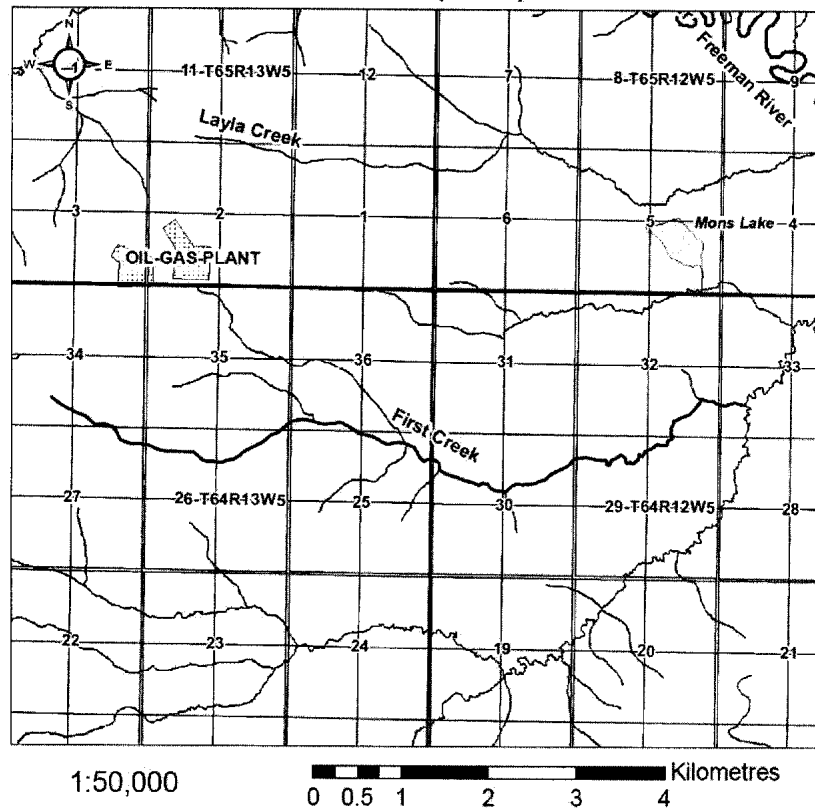

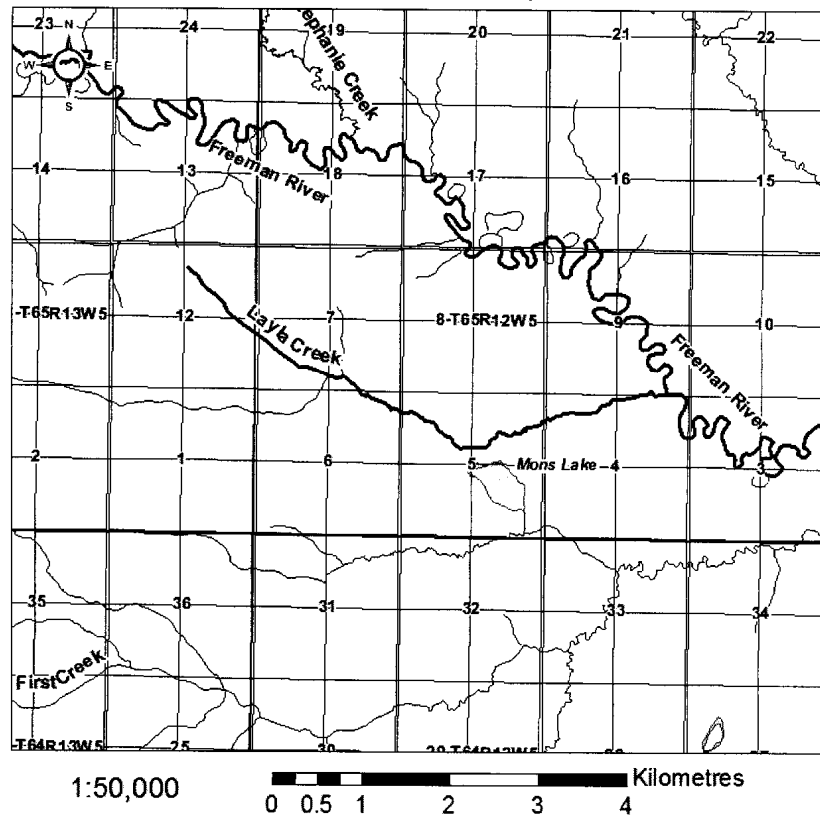
A Sketch Showing the General Vicinity of Stephanie Creek (creek)
