- (d) the assessor for the Town of Peace River must assess, for the purposes of taxation in 2013 and subsequent years the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it.

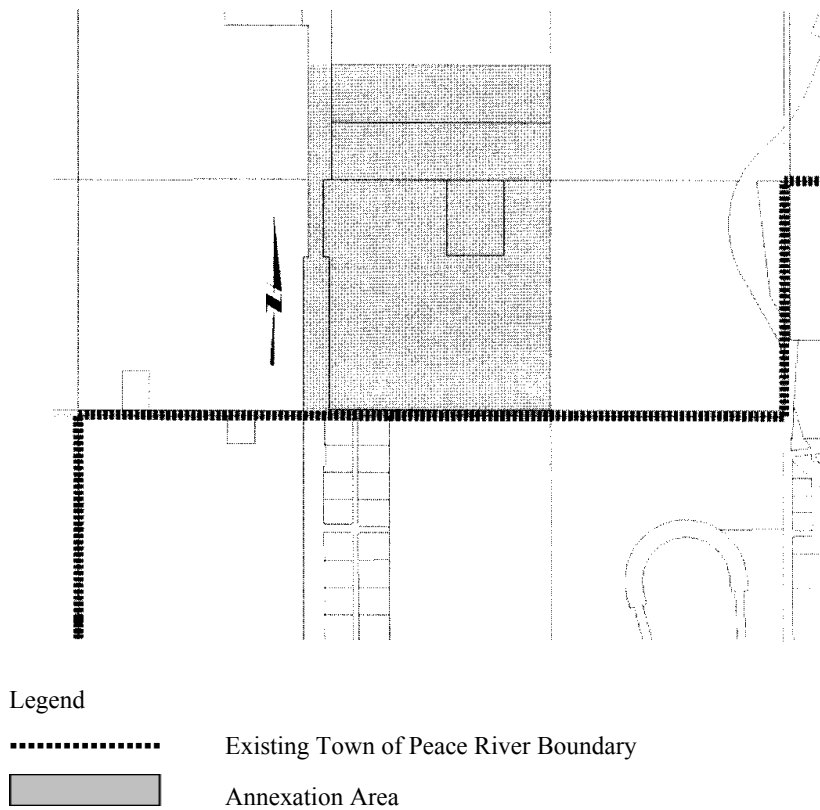

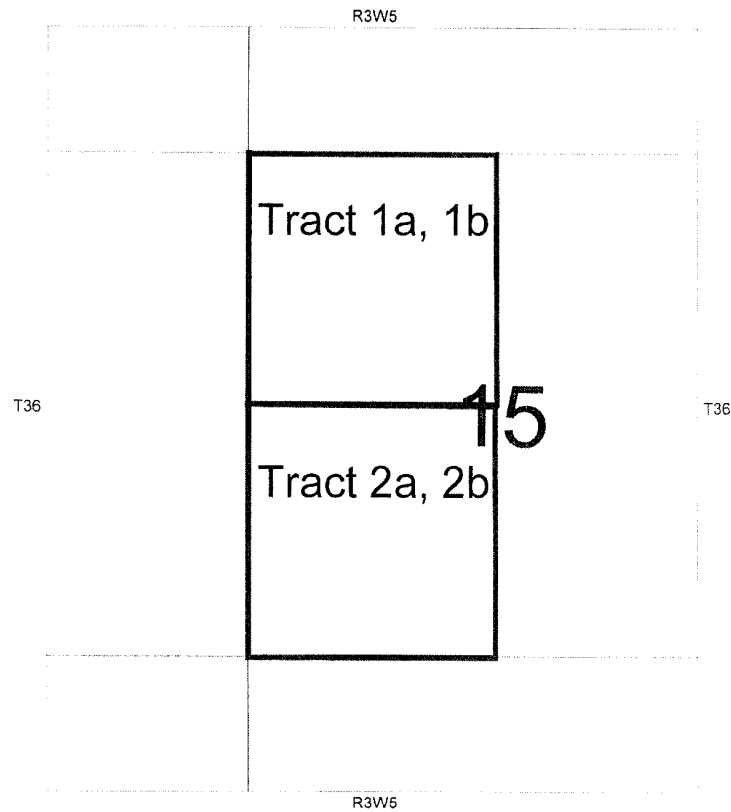
