Notice of Variation Order 07-2013

Commercial Fishing Seasons

The close times and quotas set out in Schedule 8 to the Alberta Fishery Regulations, 1998 in respect of the waters listed in the Schedule to this Notice have been varied by Variation Order 07-2013 by the Director of Fisheries Management in accordance with section 3 of the Alberta Fishery Regulations, 1998.

Where fishing with gill nets is permitted during an open season established by the Order, the gill net mesh size has been specified in the Order.

Pursuant to Variation Order 07-2013 commercial fishing is permitted in accordance with the following schedule.

SCHEDULE PART 1

Column 1 Waters – In respect of: (55.1) Lesser Slave Lake (74-11-W5) - that portion east of the eastern boundary of Range 10, west of the 5th Meridian a) In respect of the following portions of Lesser Slave Lake: i) that portion which is less than 4.88 m (16 feet) deep and which is east of the point of land where the shoreline is intersected by the western boundary of SE 17-75-9-W5M to the point of land where the eastern boundary of NW 27-75-8-W5M intersects the shoreline (Narrows towards Big Stoney Point), and ii) that portion which is less than 4.88 m (16 feet) deep and which is east of the point of land where the shoreline is intersected by the western boundary of NW 30-75-7-W5M to the point of land where the shoreline intersects the western boundary of the mouth of Lily Creek in NW 14-74-6-W5M (East of Big Stoney Point to mouth of Lily Creek).
