Squaw Coulée
(coulee)

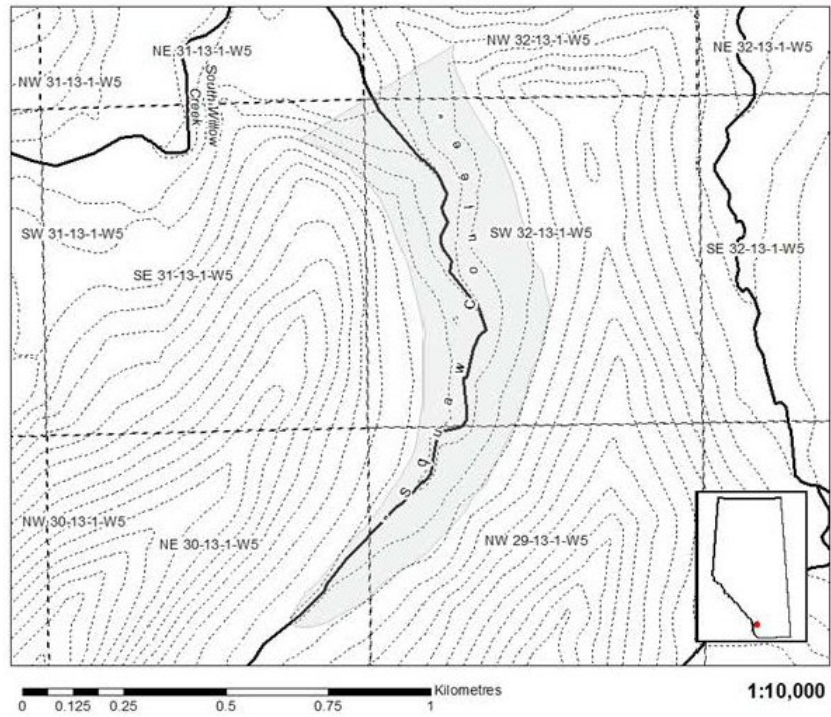

Latitude/Longitude: 50° 07' 42" N & 114° 06' 51" W)

Description: A short coulee running north into the valley of South Willow Creek, approximately 35 kilometres southwest of Nanton.

According to Blackfoot traditions and Dominion Land Survey field notes, Squaw Coulée is historically understood to be the name for a coulee further north of this land feature. This coulee near Nanton appears to have been misidentified as Squaw Coulée due to an error in correspondence between provincial and federal naming and mapping officials in 1941. The word ‘squaw’ is also widely held to be derogatory in nature. The name is rescinded due to the derogatory nature of the name and to correct the 1941 cartographic error.

Old Women’s Buffalo Jump
(buffalo jump)

Located at:

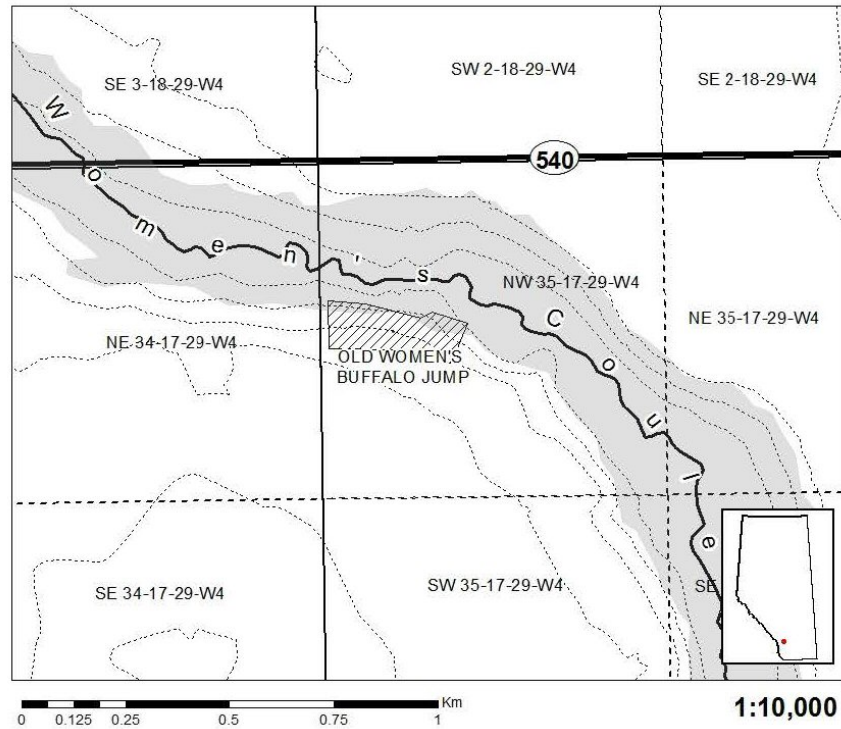

Latitude/Longitude: 50° 28’ 45” N & 113° 53’ 33” W)

Description: A section of six to seven metre high sandstone cliffs in Women’s Coulee approximately five kilometres northwest of Cayley and 60 kilometres south of Calgary. The buffalo jump is a significant archaeological site and is also known as the “Cayley Kill Site.”

According to Blackfoot traditions, this buffalo jump is one of many known as Women’s Buffalo Jump. This jump near Cayley is traditionally considered to be the most ancient of the jumps and is linked to Blackfoot traditions about the origin of mankind and the first marriages and partnerships between men and women. The word ‘old’ modifies ‘buffalo jump’ not ‘women’ and is therefore not part of the buffalo jump’s proper name.

Women’s Coulee
(coulee)

Located at:

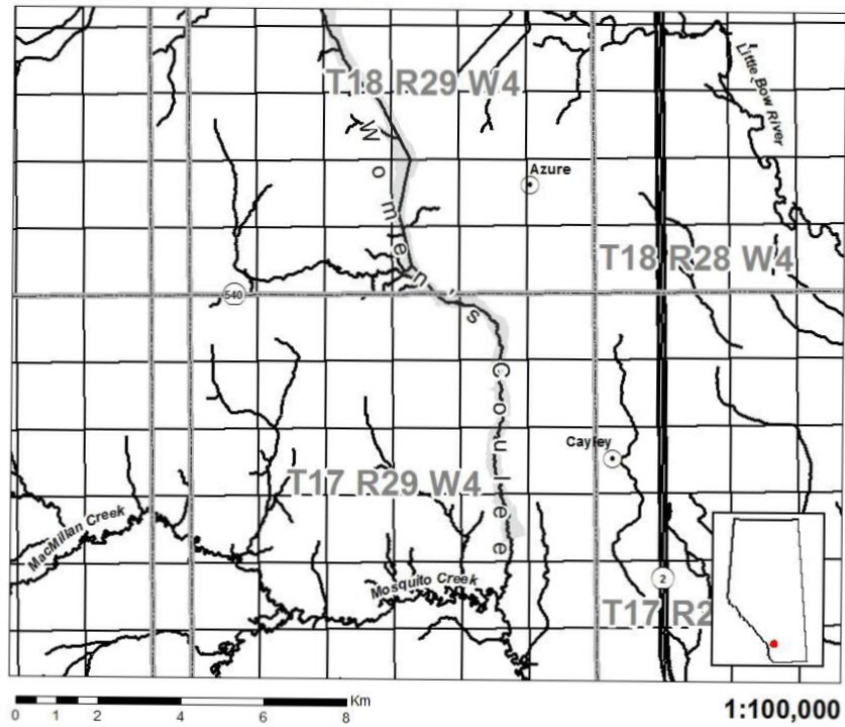
ATS: 8-14-17-29-W4 to 4-28-18-29-W4

Latitude/Longitude: 50° 32' 45" N & 113° 56' 27" W)

Description: A large coulee that runs north from Mosquito Creek (three kilometres southwest of Cayley) to the Highwood River (six kilometres southwest of High River).

The name is derived from Blackfoot traditions about the creation and the first marriages and partnerships between men and women. According to these traditions, in the earliest days, women and men lived apart. Napi (the Old Man) met the men and suggested that their lives would be improved if they lived as partners with the women. They agreed and Napi sought out the women, finding them in a large camp near a buffalo jump. The women also agreed with Napi’s suggestion and chose partners from the men. This coulee is traditionally known to be the location of the women’s camp and is known as Women’s Coulee amongst the Blackfoot.

Women’s Buffalo Jump
(buffalo jump)

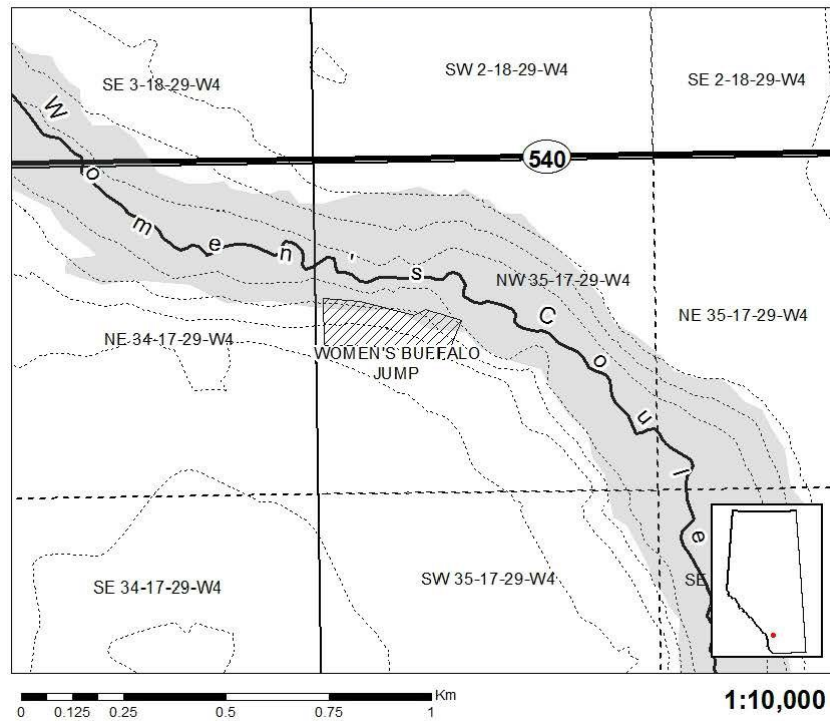

Description: A section of six to seven metre high sandstone cliffs in Women’s Coulee approximately five kilometres northwest of Cayley and 60 kilometres south of Calgary. The buffalo jump is a significant archeological site and is also known as the “Cayley Kill Site.”

The name is derived from Blackfoot traditions about the creation and the first marriages and partnerships between men and women. In the earliest days, women and men lived apart. Napi (the Old Man) met the men and suggested that their lives would be improved if they lived as partners with the women. They agreed and Napi sought out the women, finding them in a large camp near a buffalo jump. The women also agreed with Napi’s suggestion and chose partners from amongst the men. The women’s camp is traditionally understood to be near this buffalo jump in Women’s Coulee and both the coulee and buffalo jump are named for this event. Archaeological evidence shows that the buffalo jump was brought into use approximately 2700 to 1500 years ago, but it fell into disuse by the mid-1800s. The name of the buffalo jump was recorded as “Woman’s Pound” by the Geological Survey of Canada in 1883 and it has become known as the “Old Women’s Buffalo Jump” since its rediscovery in the 1950s. Blackfoot traditions are that the buffalo jump is properly known as Women’s Buffalo Jump, with the word ‘old’ being a modifier and not part of the proper name.

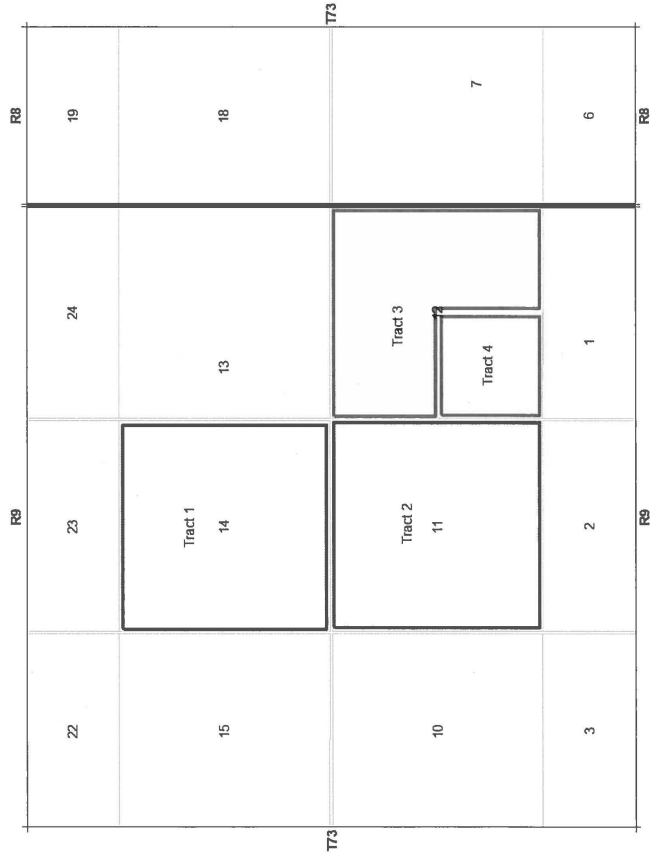

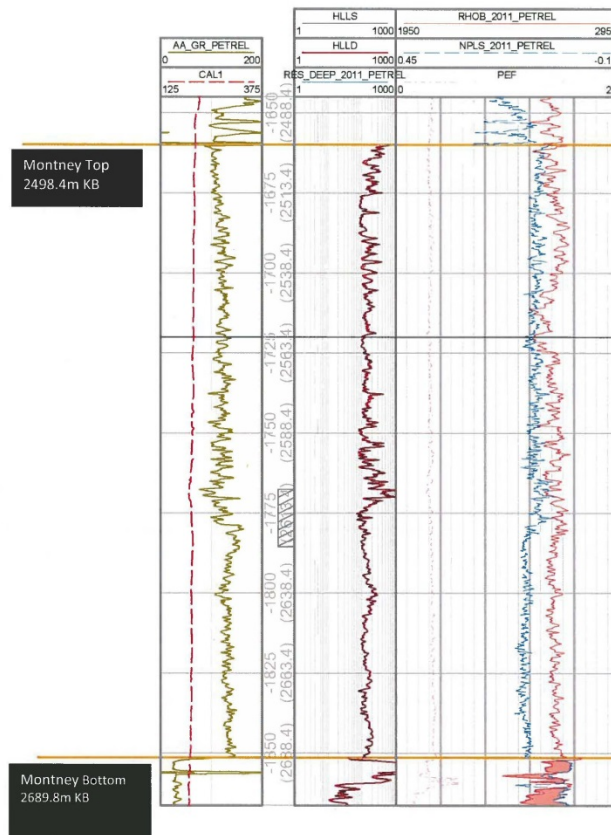

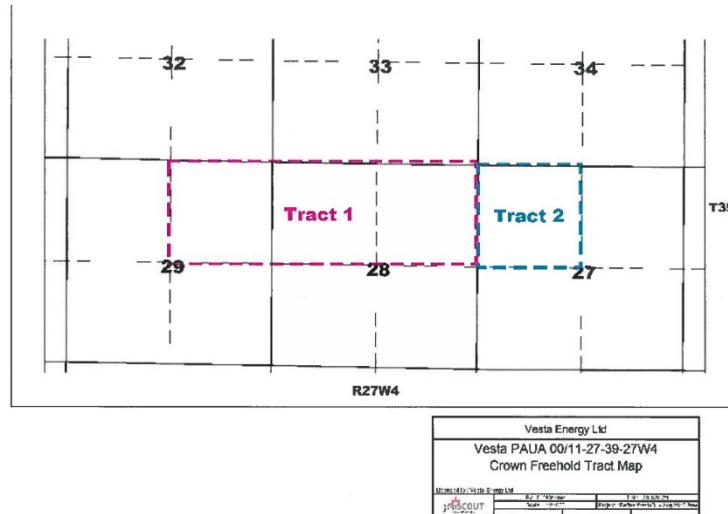

[PLAT OF UNIT AREA]



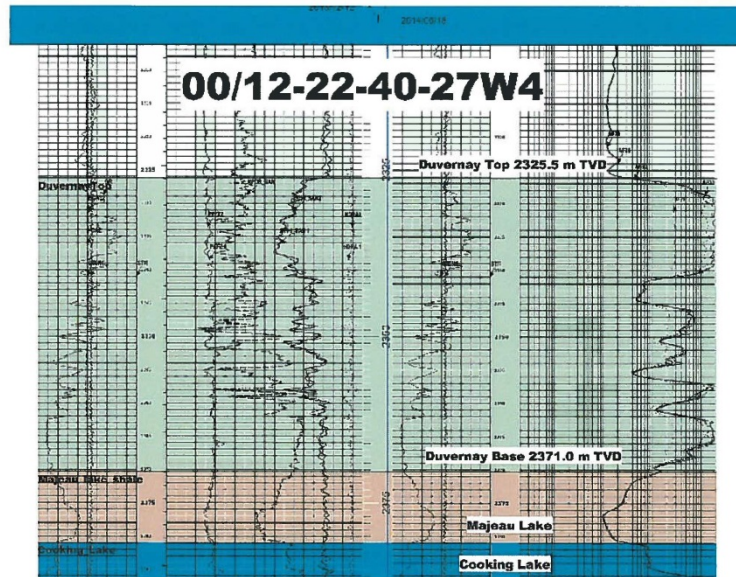
