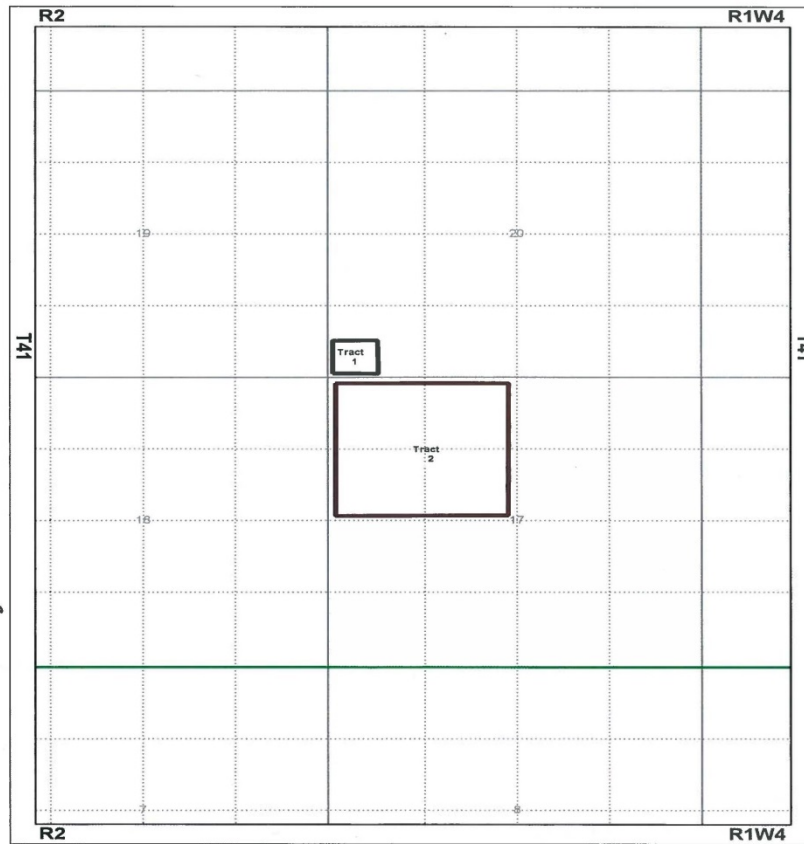

PLAT OF UNIT AREA

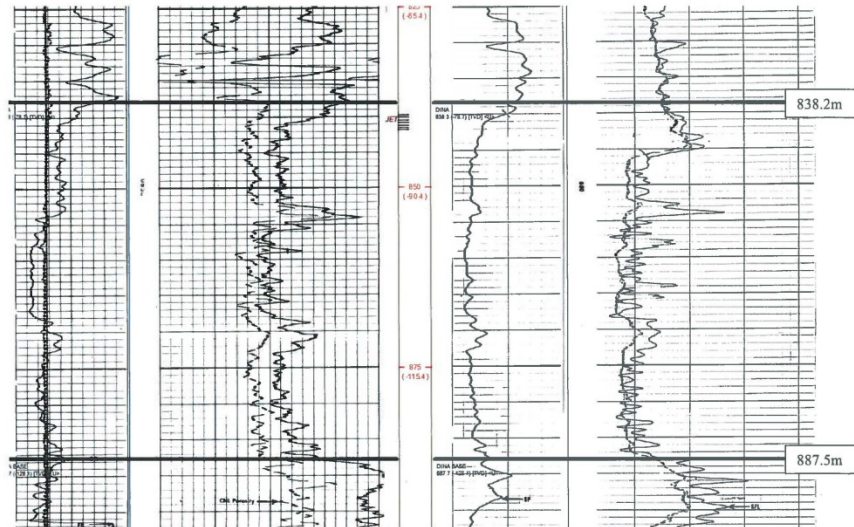

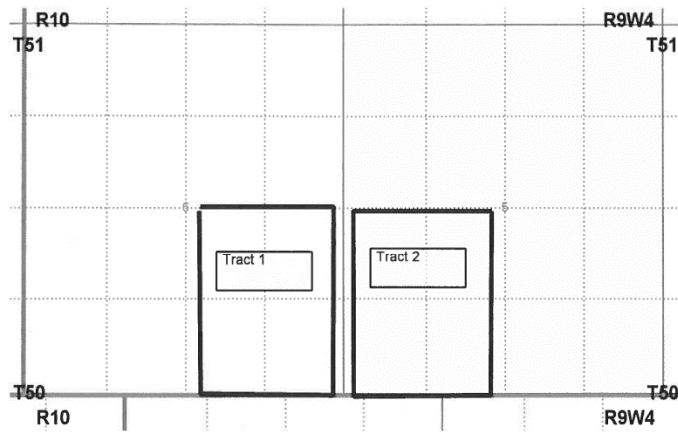
