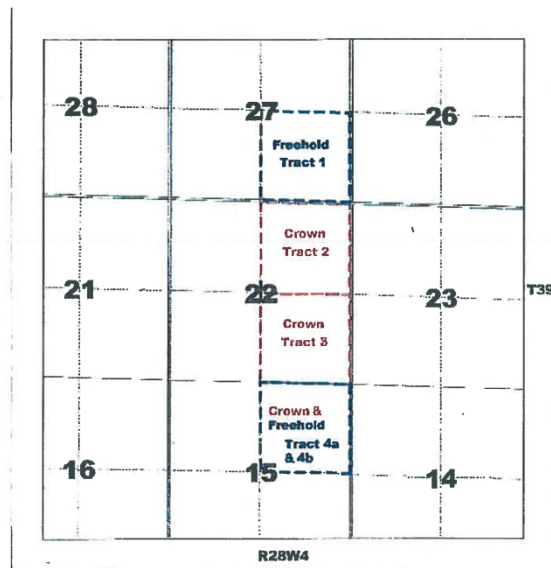

Cygnat Duvernay Agreement No. 1



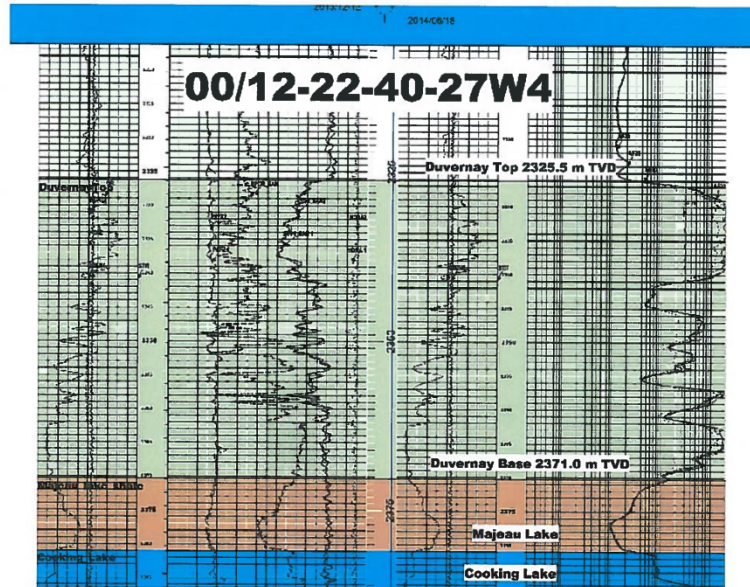

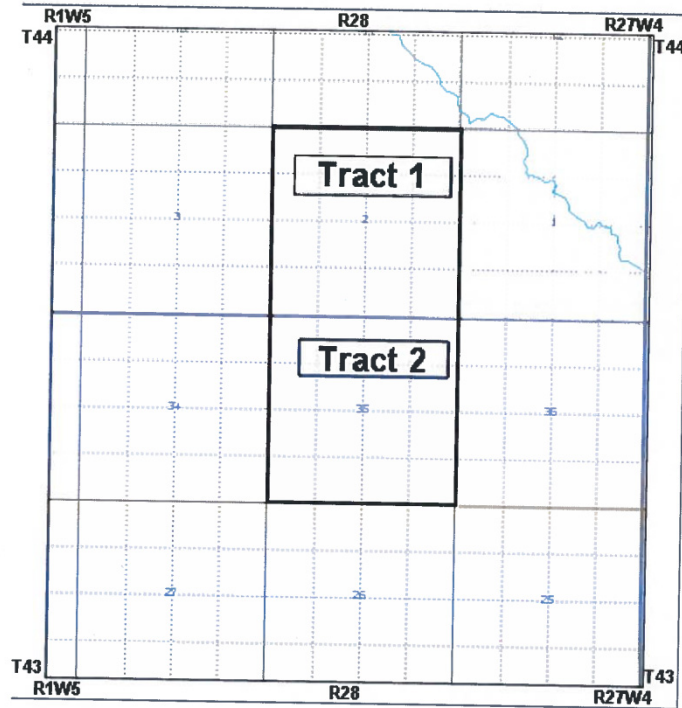

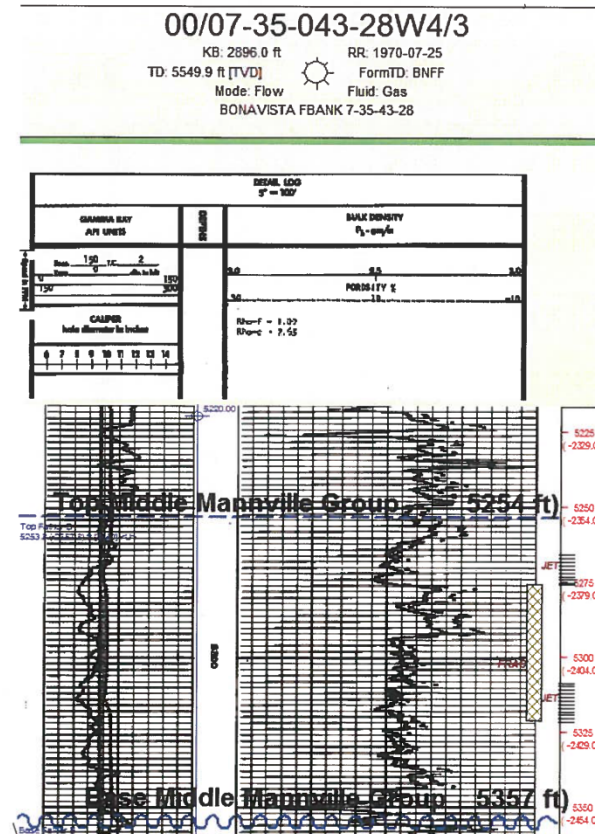

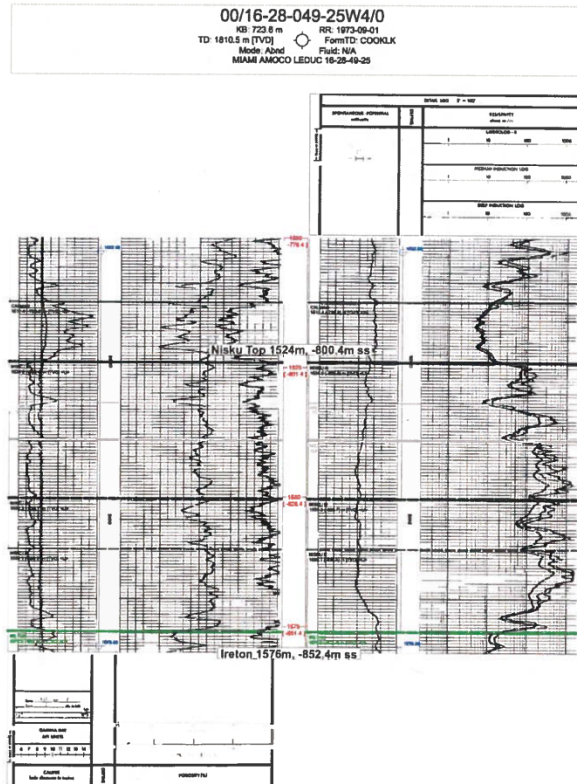

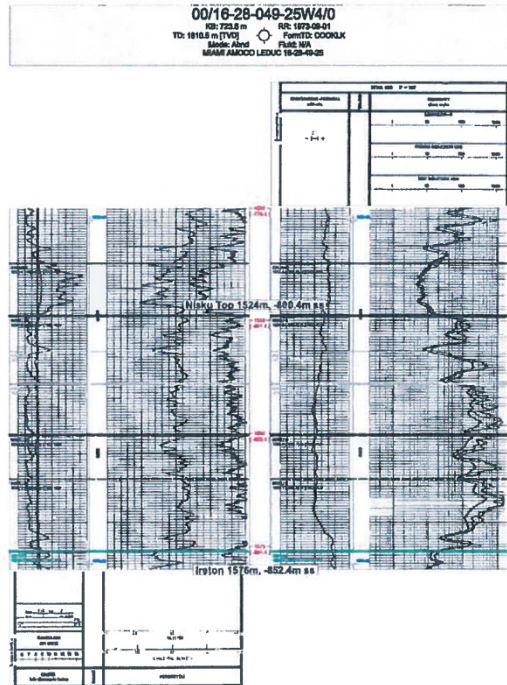
