Notice of Rescinding of Registered Historic Resources

(Historical Resources Act)

On December 9, 2020, amendments to the *Historical Resources Act* came into force which eliminate the Registered Historic Resources designation. These amendments were made in order to eliminate a designation that did not provide meaningful protections to historic resources. Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 54 of the *Historical Resources Act*, all Registered Historic Resource orders are rescinded.

The registration of Registered Historic Resources designations shall be removed from certificates of title as soon as practicable. Owners will be notified in writing and provided information regarding other historic resource designations available for their property.

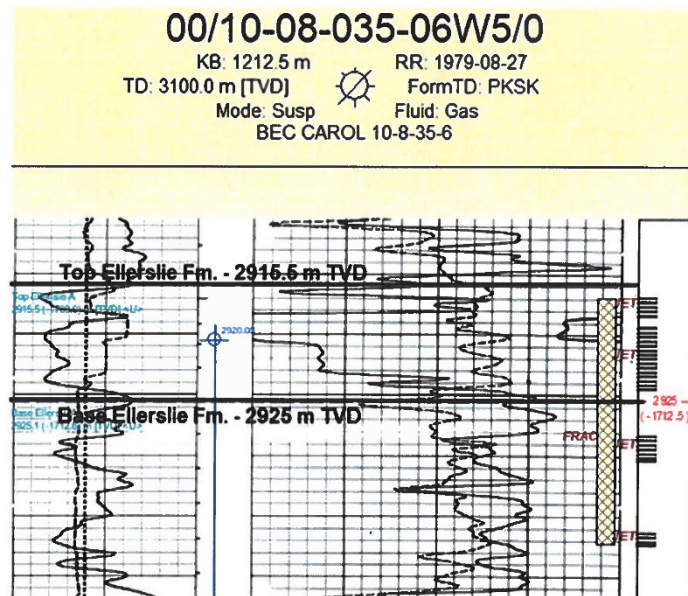
