APPENDIX

BIG ISLAND PROVINCIAL PARK

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the fifty-first (51) township, in the twenty-fifth (25) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

(A) Island No. 1 and Island No. 3 in the North Saskatchewan River, as referenced on a plan of survey of the said township signed at Ottawa on the 7th day of March 1929, the said Island No. 1 being now known locally as Big Island.

(B) All those portions of the north half of section twenty-nine (29) and the south half of section thirty-two (32) of the said township, lying generally to the north and west of the said Island No. 1 (Big Island) and to the south and east of the left bank of the said North Saskatchewan River which comprise the bed and shore of the said North Saskatchewan River.

(C) All those portions of the north east quarter of the said section twenty-nine (29), the south east quarter of the said section thirty-two (32) and the south west quarter of section thirty-three (33) of the said township, comprised of the bed and shore of the said North Saskatchewan River and lying generally to the south and east of the south eastern bank of the said Island No. 1 (Big Island), generally to the north and west of the center line of the main channel of the said North Saskatchewan River and being downstream of the southernmost extent and upstream of the north easternmost extent of the said Island No. 1 (Big Island).

(D) All intervening statutory road allowances and intersections within the lands herein described, (A) through (C).

The lands herein described contain seventy-eight and seven hundred seventy-five thousandths (78.775) hectares (194.66 acres), more or less.

(Blackfoot First Nations Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Regulation)

Pursuant to the *First Nations Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Act* (FNSCORA) and the *Blackfoot First Nations Sacred Ceremonial Objects Repatriation Regulation* made under that Act, the Province of Alberta as represented by the Minister of Culture hereby gives notice of receipt of a repatriation application from a member of the Blackfoot Crossing Historical Foundation for an object in the Government of Alberta's collections at the Royal Alberta Museum (RAM).

The application is for the repatriation of a:

1. Small rawhide rattle, attributed to the Siksika Nation and the Prairie Chicken or Mad Dog Society (accession number H65.128.1) which came into possession of the RAM in 1965.
2. Small rawhide rattle, attributed to the Siksika Nation and Mad Dog Society (accession number H65.129.1) which came into possession of the RAM in 1965.
3. Small rawhide rattle, attributed to the Siksika Nation and Mad Dog Society (accession number H66.87.43) which came into possession of the RAM in 1966.
4. Rawhide rattle, attributed to the Siksika Nation and Mad Dog Society (catalogue number AF 227) which came into possession of Glenbow Museum in 1965.
5. Rattle attributed to the Siksika Nation (catalogue number AF 450) at the Glenbow Museum.
6. Rattle attributed to the Siksika Nation and the Crazy Dog Society (catalogue number AF 2333) at the Glenbow Museum.
7. Rattle attributed to the Siksika Nation (catalogue number AF 3600) which came into possession of the Glenbow Museum in 1975.
8. Rattle attributed to the Siksika Nation (catalogue number AF 3652) which came into possession of the Glenbow Museum in 1975.
9. Weasel Tail Suit (Shirt) attributed to the Siksika Nation (catalogue number AF 3621) used in Sundance ceremonies and during relevant bundle openings at the Glenbow Museum.

Any person with interest in these objects, who either wishes to make written representations to the Minister relating to this application or to submit an application of their own, must do so within 30 days after publication of this notice in The Alberta Gazette. Repatriation of the above pieces to Kent Ayoungman, as the designated representative of the Blackfoot Crossing Historical Foundation, may proceed after the 30-day period if the object listed in the application is determined to meet the criteria of a sacred ceremonial object as defined in FNSCORA, no additional applications or contrary written representations have been made, and if the Minister considers repatriation to be appropriate.

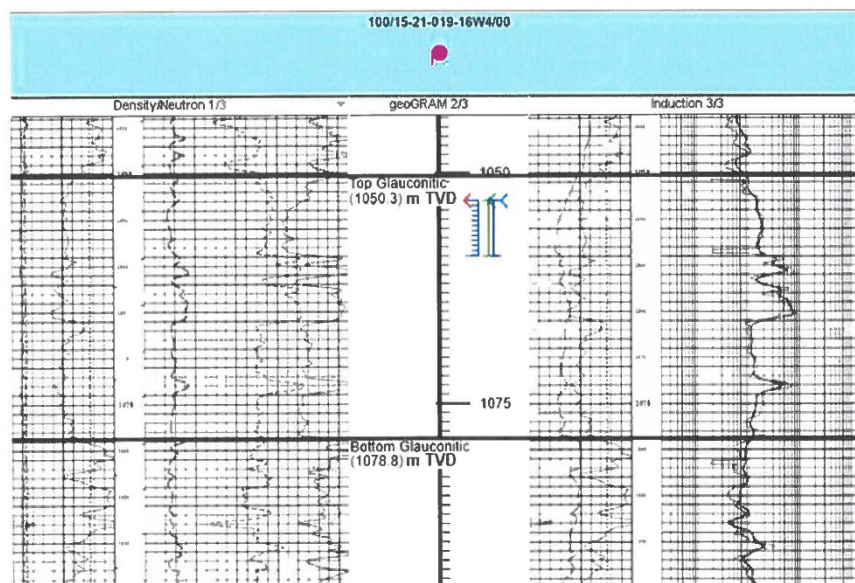

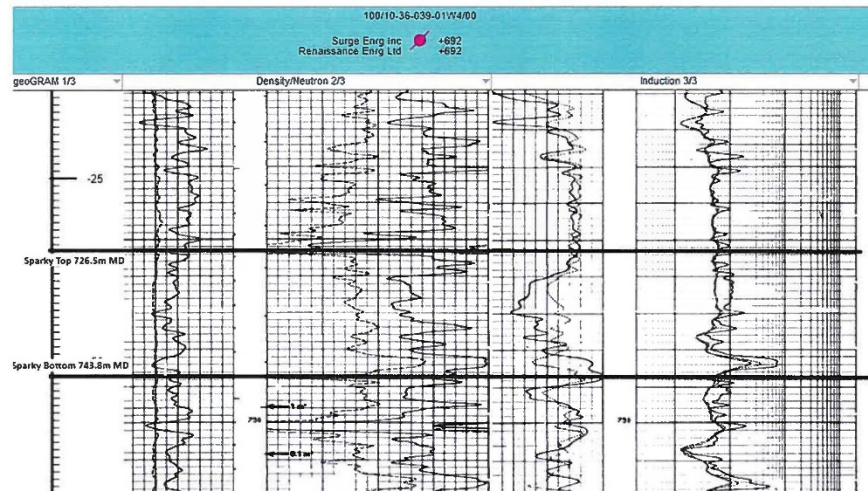

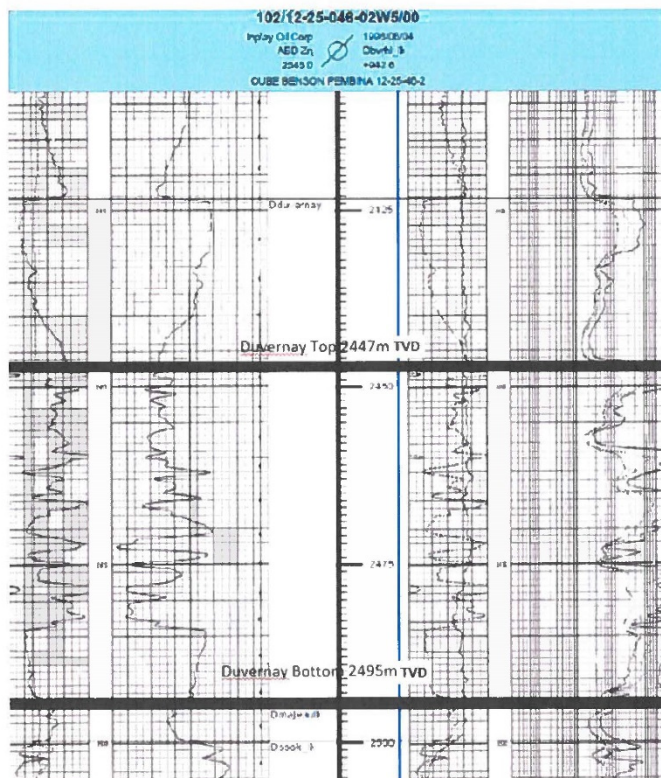

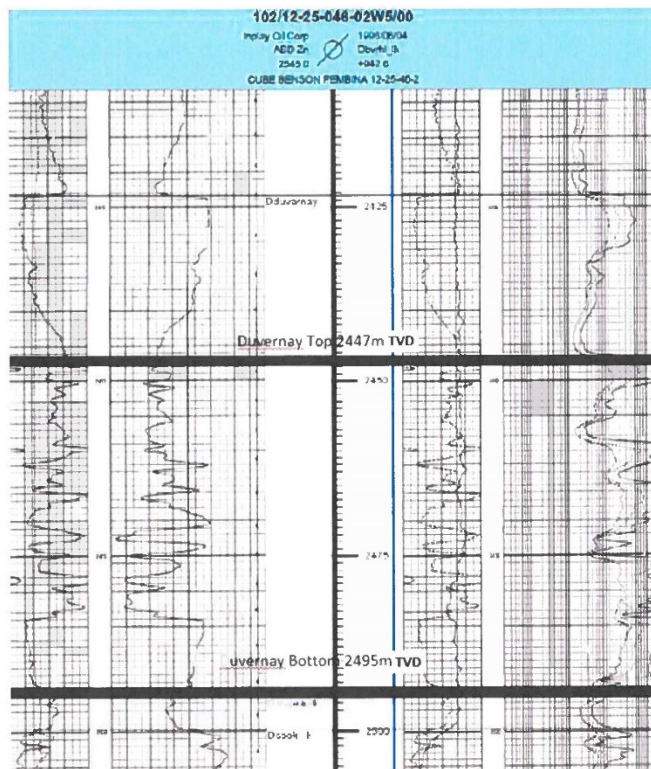
