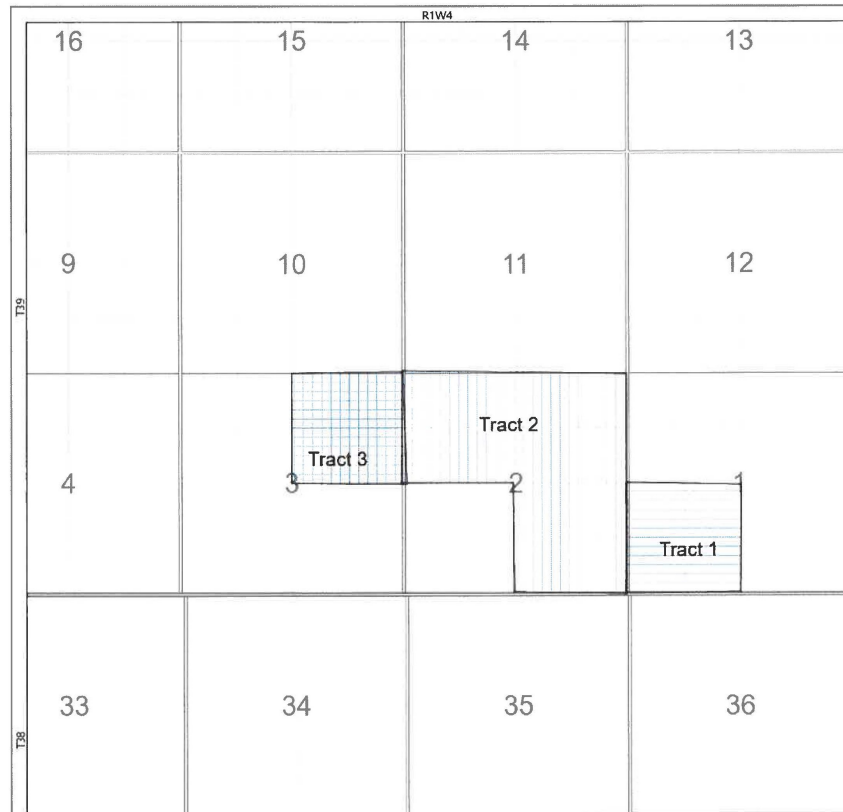

[PLAT OF UNIT AREA]



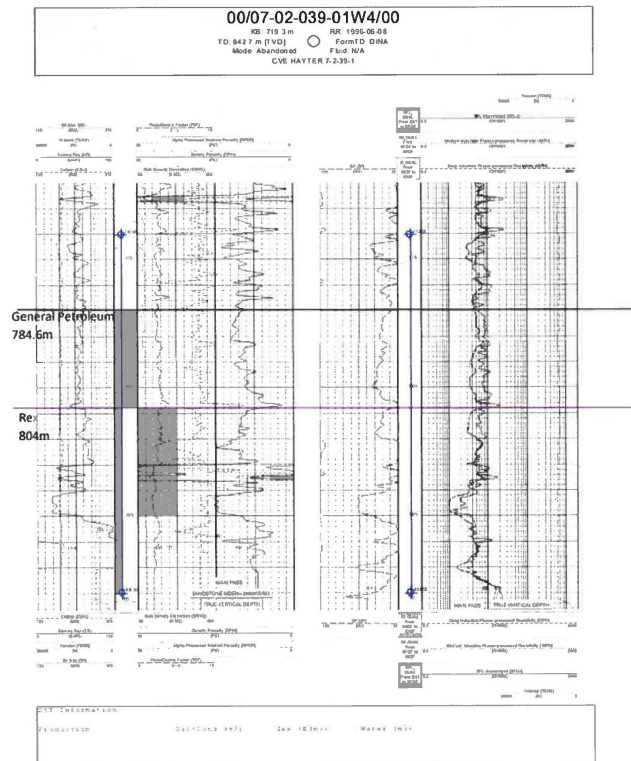

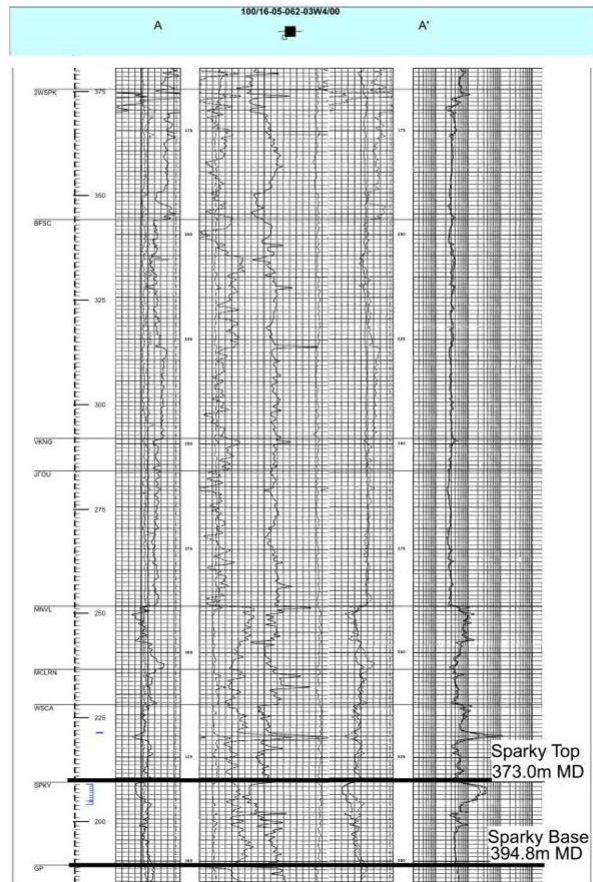
